OUR GOAL is to concentrate on fish and wildlife projects within the Jackfish Lake Watershed.

The Lost Horse Creek Wildlife Federation was established in 2008 and was named after Lost Horse Creek which flows into Murray Lake. Since our membership has steadily grown to 130 members. We currently rent the Cochin Rink Building as our meeting place. We have completed a fish habitat restoration project on Lehman Creek and are now working on raising funds to build and maintain a mini walleye hatchery for Jackfish & Murray Lakes, with plans to expand to Little Loon, Helene and Turtle Lake in the future.

For the past two years we have built and maintained an outdoor ice skating rink on Lehman Creek for our future Outdoors men and women and is open to all.

Our annual fundraising events include a **Fish Filleting Demonstration** and **Membership drive** on the May Long weekend at the Murray Lake boat launch, a **Fish Fry and Awards Presentation** in July, **Boat Rally** in August and a **Horn Scoring** in December.
